Frequently Asked Questions



- How will students be chosen for the GRAMMY Museum's Music Revolution Project?
 - Students who submit the required application and performance audio/video file will be reviewed by the GRAMMY Museum staff

- What is the age range for the GRAMMY Museum's Music Revolution Project?
 - Students between the ages of 14 – 19 will be able to participate

- How much will it cost for my student to participate in The GRAMMY Museum's Music Revolution Project?
 - Nothing! The Music Revolution Project is free for students who are chosen to participate

- Where does the program take place?
 - MRP will take place in a number of cities in 2017 including:
 1. Los Angeles, California
 2. Tampa Bay, Florida
 3. Cleveland, Mississippi
 4. Corvallis, Oregon
 5. The Valley, Anguilla

- What are the program dates?
 - The GRAMMY Museum's Music Revolution Project will take place in cities across the country and internationally. Please check grammymuseum.org/education for individual dates

- What are the hours my student will need to be at the Music Revolution Project?
 - The program will run Monday through Friday, from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM

- How will my student get to the program?
 - Students are required to have their own transportation to the program, however parking will be provided for the students

 - Yes. Please have students bring a bagged lunch or money to purchase lunch in the area
